Nominations for emergency services juniors and cadets to attend the inaugural DFES Senior Cadet Leadership Camp is now open.

Nominations close on 27 July 2018. No late nominations will be accepted.

This camp provides an amazing opportunity for senior cadets and juniors to experience the unique surroundings of Karijini National Park in the Pilbara, while learning hands on emergency services skills in a challenging environment outside their normal comfort zone.

Selected candidates will spend two full days in the national park with qualified Tom Price SES members, roping and exploring gorges such as Knox, Red, Joffre and Hancock Gorge. This is a great opportunity for proactive young leaders to learn new skills, meet other juniors and cadets and develop their leadership potential.

We are contacting all Emergency Services Cadet Corps Leaders and Instructors, in addition to all emergency services volunteers who are members of a brigade, group or unit which have registered youth volunteers.

ELIGIBILITY FOR PARTICIPANTS

- Be aged between 15-18 years old.
- Be registered as an emergency services junior or cadet member of a brigade, group or unit (BGU), or a school-based Emergency Services Cadet Corp (ESCC).
- Be a committed and proactive member of their BGU or ESCC unit.
- Have a reasonable level of fitness to hike through gorges and swim in natural pools and waterfalls.

NOMINATIONS NOW OPEN

For safety reasons, only 16 juniors/cadets will be able to attend this camp.
