One of the roles we have is to support the 'Firies' when they are involved in large bush fires, by filling up the water bomber planes with water and foam. Each year before the bush fire season we train to replenish the special aircraft - refresher for 'old' members and a new ex-

perience for some of our newer members like Aimee Weier. The pilot also gets a bit of practice with his accuracy of dropping water on a pre-determined location at the end of the training.
