Training and other activities :-

12th May - Rope Rescue Systems training :

This was a continuation refresher training for the cliff rescue team members on safety and setting up rope systems and for the remainder basic rope training with knots and abseil off the training tower. The systems included setting up a Tryolean system between the top of the training tower and an SES vehicle situated 25 metres away. A 'rescue' from the tower involving a 'casualty' being escorted by another volunteer. After which several of the unit members then utilized the setup just for the fun and thrill of experiencing the activity.

26th May - USAR - Search and Rescue Procedural Training :

Based on the updated requirement for emergency services personnel to be accepted as being formally qualified to safely rescue people from collapsed buildings resulting from natural disasters such as earthquakes and storms, 12 of the units volunteers qualified for this USAR cat 1 course.

31st May Community Support :

SES volunteers provided assistance in setting up the Kalbarri Canoe and Cray Carnival weekend event on the foreshore and during the canoeing activities provided boat safety support.
