#### **ANZAC DAY PARADE 2014**

An invitation is extended to all DFES Operations personnel, including retired members, volunteers and veterans, to participate as part of a contingent in the Perth City, ANZAC Day Parade.

The opportunity to be a part of this significant national occasion is an honour and I am confident that all personnel that support the parade will enjoy the event. DFES Operations is keen to support the ANZAC tradition and the values it promotes such as mateship and teamwork. We also welcome all those who may not have had the opportunity to participate in this event previously.

As we approach the ANZAC centenary, in 2015, it is important that DFES personnel, who are eligible to march as veterans, are given every opportunity and support to participate in the march.

As a sign of respect and honour to the ANZAC's and the ANZAC tradition the following dress standard is compulsory. Personal Protective Clothing must not be worn. Note these dress requirements apply only for personnel who wish to march as part of the Perth City parade. Many local governments run parades for ANZAC Day and dress requirements for DFES Operations staff and volunteers are to be determined through the relevant local government in consultation with DFES regional managers.
