

Operation in November :-

6th November :- Search at Lucky Bay—2 boys missing after leaving vehicle which had become bogged in sand dunes. Ten volunteers responded and after meeting up with WAPOL on site boys found safe and we were able to return to base, Very wet weather meant access was difficult on the dirt road into the area....

14th November :- Fire support to crews fighting bush fires in National Park south of Kalbarri– supply of meals to volunteers.

Training and other activities:-

Sunday 1st—3rd :- Rope Rescue Systems Regional course with 26 participants, students, instructors and support staff from state locations ranging from Esperance to Steep Point—this was a big course, which was organized in Kalbarri which has the needed facilities and natural locations. After initial training at the unit—under controlled conditions the course moved to 'on-location' at Gregory Rock alongside the river south of Murchison House station and then to the gorge location at Hawks Head in the National Park.

Monday 9th:- 'Maintenance & Organising' evening to setup vehicles and equipment to check/ensure they are in ready state for deployments.

Saturday 14th :- SES advisory committee meeting at 'The Bunker' in Belmont to review issues that affect SES volunteers throughout WA.
