**Title:** Local Manager – State Emergency Service (SES)

### About the role:

The Local Manager (LM) Gnowangerup SES is responsible for the efficient and effective management of the Gnowangerup SES Unit. This position works closely with the District Officer Natural Hazards Great Southern and the Shire of Gnowangerup to ensure the Unit is prepared for operational requirements. The LM is also encouraged to become a member of the Local Emergency Management Committee (LEMC) to contribute to the development of the local emergency management arrangements. The LM ensures the development of exercises and training to maintain response capabilities and promotes awareness campaigns within the community.

As the Local Manager for the Gnowangerup SES unit, you will be responsible for:

### Management

- Managing the functions of the SES Unit
- Preparing the Unit Development Plan, including personal development of members
- Managing the assets, finances, volunteers and equipment of the Unit.
- Ensuring Unit compliance with DFES Policies and Doctrine
- Mentoring members in other leadership roles and identify succession planning opportunities
- Examining opportunities for development of the Unit through innovation
- Participating in regional management and development forums

### Operations

- Ensuring the effective direction of Unit resources during operations

- Liaising with the Local Emergency Coordinator and other relevant services as required
- Ensuring the DFES ComCen and Regional Duty Coordinator (RDC), as appropriate, are informed of Unit activations and operations
- Ensuring Incident Reports are completed / submitted

### Training

- Ensuring the Training Manager develops the Unit Training Program
- Approving the Unit Training Program

### Emergency Management

- Participating as a member of the Local Emergency Management Committee (LEMC)
- Advising DFES on the Units operational capability
- Overseeing Unit community engagement activities and preparing the Unit for relevant Hazard Management Agency roles and responsibilities

### Administration

- Ensuring Non-Operational Activity Reports (NOAR) and Incident Reporting System reports are completed / submitted in a timely manner
- Developing the annual budget submission in consultation with LG and DO
- Managing expenditure in accordance with the LGGGS process
- Maintain online consumables stock levels register
- Ensuring the Unit Asset Register is maintained and checked annually
- Overseeing Unit administration

### Selection Criteria

#### Essential

- Strong communication and interpersonal skills including the ability to deal with people from a wide variety of backgrounds and influence stakeholders
- Demonstrated leadership skills
- Previous experience in developing and implementing policies and procedures

## Desirable

- Completion of, or working toward, Unit Management Pathway
- Knowledge of the Department of Fire and Emergency Services
- Broad knowledge of the SES and its role
- Completion of the SES Local Manager Course
- Completion of Introduction to AIIMS and/or AIIMS 2017
- Completion of, or working toward, formal emergency management training
- Endorsed as a Level 1 Incident Controller
- Level 2 Operations Officer or working towards the qualification
- Experience in managing volunteers
